Information

Entry fee: \$0

Eligibility

19 years and under as at January 1st, 2018.
Must have a GA handicap at an affiliated GPV club.

How it works

Play in at least 5 of the 10 Junior Order of Merit events. The system will calculate your best 4 results, and the boy and girl with the most points at the end of the year will be crowned GPV Junior Order of Merit Champions (gross and nett sections).

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY AND COMPETITION

HISTORY

2018 is the inaugural year of the GPV Junior Order of Merit, which has been endorsed and supported by Golf Peninsula Vic and Golf Victoria.

COMPETITION

The GPV Junior Order of Merit will be overarching junior program run by Golf Peninsula Vic. Played over the calendar year, points will be allocated to GPV juniors at the nominated GPV Junior Order of Merit events (ranking events) based upon players finishing position. See points system in 'scoring' section.

ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open to male and female junior amateurs who are 19 years and under as at January 1st, 2018 and hold a GA handicap at an affiliated GPV club.

ENTRIES

No registration is required. Scores for those eligible will be automatically included post each ranking event.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

- A.** Where an event is abandoned or curtailed, the number of event/s so lost will be deducted from the minimum required to be eligible for the trophies.
- B.** Competitors must play 5 rounds to be eligible for the title with the best 4 point tallies to count. Once a player has played 5 events, the best 4 results are calculated as follows: 5 events - lowest point tally deleted, 6 events - lowest 2 point tallies deleted, 7 events - lowest 3 point tallies deleted and so on.
- C.** In the event of a tie, a countback will apply as follows. The player with the most points across the entire season (using all results) will be the winner. If a tie still exists, the player who placed better in the GPV Junior Masters will be the winner.
- D.** 2018 GPV Standard Event Conditions and GPV Code of Conduct apply for all GPV Junior Order of Merit events.

SCORING

To qualify the GPV Order of Merit (gross and nett), a player must play a minimum of 5 events on the GPV Junior Order of Merit Calendar.



OOM Event Calendar

The best 4 scores from the year will be totalled, and the best total score in each section will be named the 2018 GPV Junior Order of Merit Champions (Gross & Nett).

Players will be awarded points in events as published in the below table.
If there are tied scores the points will be averaged across those scores.
